The Egyptian Ministry of Communications and Information Technology, in cooperation with the Ministry of Higher Education, intends to establish a non-profit IT based university in the Knowledge City of the New Capital. The university aims at integrating information technology in the educational process, for the implementation of digital transformation strategy.

Considered as the one of the most important educational and cultural projects in Egypt in terms of location and

size, the project includes university buildings (6 faculties) on a plot area of 82,433 m² and with a total built-up area of 202,626 m² for faculties' buildings, administration building, and the main library. This adds to a social club on a plot area of 25,833 m², and with a total built-up area of 14,602 m².
